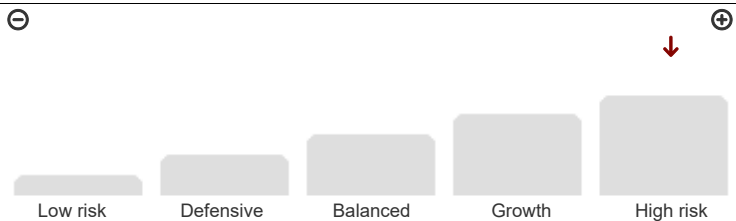


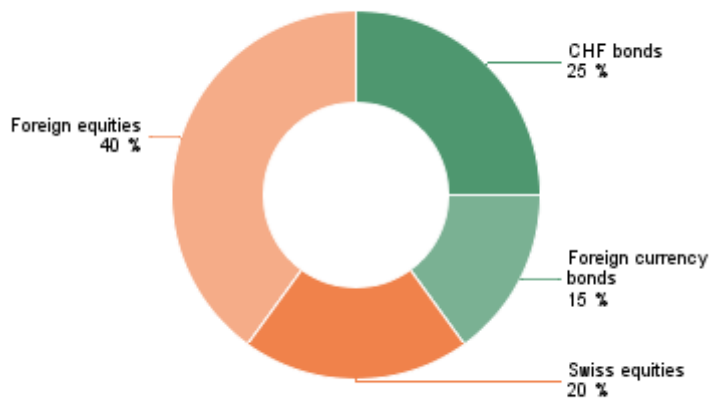
Strategy description
